Briefing Item

1. 23-0762 Tacoma FIRST 311 Update

At approximately 12:01 p.m., La'Toya Mason, Customer Service Manager and Morgan Medley, Customer Service Analyst, City Manager's Office, presented an update on the Tacoma FIRST 311 system, including an agenda; background, noting public access, service, and security initiative; Customer Support Center; how Tacoma FIRST 311 works; why people should utilize the system; and transactions from 2013 to 2023. Medley concluded with the GovQA and SeeClickFix (SCF) top ten requests; first year of SCF trends; Council District breakdown by GovQA and SCF; data from 2013 through 2022, noting popular request categories, sources, and totals; and improvements, noting mobile improvements.

Discussion ensued regarding the ten-year anniversary; feedback, including calls for debris, garbage, and homeless encampments; communication with departments, noting active reporting per department, jurisdictional processes, geofencing, and data filtering; service levels and departmental accountability; specifics on parking issue requests; average request close-out time and

process; public and privatized requests; permit dashboard; community outreach and QR codes; next steps and future options; and emergency management collaboration.
