Overview

- Public Hearing on setting the City of Tacoma's property tax levies:
 - Regular property tax levy which supports the General Fund
 - Emergency Medical Services (EMS) levy which supports the EMS fund
- 2013 Assessed Values (AV) are up 3.5% over 2012
- New Construction AV more than doubled between 2012 and 2013

Regular Property Tax Levy

Next week's ordinances will authorize the 2014 property tax levy at \$52.2 M, which is a 1% increase over the highest regular levy

Emergency Medical Services Levy

Next week's ordinances will authorize an increase in the EMS levy to the maximum allowed, given the statutory rate maximum of \$0.5 per \$1,000 of AV
