••••OVERVIEW



- Increase False Alarm Fee
- Add option for No Response by police after five false alarms (excluding hold-up, robbery, panic)
- Enhance monitoring company requirements to verify need for police response

••••OVERVIEW



- Amendments intended to:
 - Decrease the number of false alarm calls
 - Focus on locations that generate a higher number of false alarms

***BACKGROUND



2003 - Alarm License and False Alarm Fees established

- False alarm calls were close to 12,000
- False Alarm Fee set at \$60

2012 - False Alarm fee increased to \$100

*******ISSUE



- False Alarms have decreased by 88% since 2003
- Significant number of locations generating multiple false alarms
- Over 50% of false alarms triggered by 25% of locations

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

- Increase False Alarm fee
- Create a tiered structure that increases for more than two false alarms in calendar year
- Add option to issue No Response

False Alarm		
Occurrence	Current	Proposed
1 or 2	\$100	\$115
3 or 4	\$100	\$215
5 or 6	\$100	\$265
More than 6	\$100	\$315

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

- Alarm monitoring company requirements
 - Alarm Confirmation requires companies to confirm the presence of human(s) and a high probability that a criminal offense is in progress
 - Enhanced Call Confirmation requires a minimum of two calls to verify alarm is valid
 - Exemption added from the two-call requirement if the alarm is verified through Alarm Confirmation
- Process for monitoring companies to request cancellation of false alarm fee

- Adopting a different fee structure for false alarms
- Not increasing the false alarm fee
