

## **RESOLUTION NO. 39922**

A RESOLUTION relating to surplus property, authorizing the Declaration of Surplus and execution of a Quitclaim Deed to convey two parcels, located at 5402 South Puget Sound Avenue and 3520 South 54<sup>th</sup> Street, and 5401 and 5407 South Tacoma Way, to Eli Moreno for the amount of \$850,000.

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2017, the City purchased these Properties located at 5402 South Puget Sound Avenue and 3520 South 54<sup>th</sup> Street, and 5401 and 5407 South Tacoma Way ("Properties"), for the purpose of redeveloping the Properties for use as a youth and young adult drop-in center and overnight shelter; following acquisition of the Properties, a feasibility study determined the available space would not accommodate the needs of serving the youth and young adult population at this location, and

WHEREAS the Properties, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A," are now surplus to the City's needs, and

WHEREAS the proposed purchaser, Eli Moreno, plans to develop the Properties into a co-work space, and has offered to pay the City the full asking price of \$850,000, with payments spread over five years, and

WHEREAS the City must dispose of City-owned surplus property pursuant to the City's Policy for the Sale/Disposition of City-owned General Government Real Property, and

WHEREAS, there being no foreseeable need for continued City ownership of the Properties, the sale of said Properties appears to be in the best interests of the City, pending final approval from the City Council; Now, Therefore,



## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That continued ownership of the City real Properties located at 5402 South Puget Sound Avenue and 3520 South 54<sup>th</sup> Street, and 5401 and 5407 South Tacoma Way, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A," is not essential to the needs of the City and are hereby declared surplus pursuant to RCW 35.22.020 and Article I, Section 1.2, and Article IX of the Tacoma City Charter.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to declare surplus and enter into a Quitclaim Deed to convey the subject parcels to Eli Moreno, for the amount of \$850,000, said document to be substantially in the form of the deed on file in the office of the City Clerk.
