**SUMMARY:**

Appointing and reappointing the following individuals to the Sustainable Tacoma Commission:

Appointing Alison Baur and Theda Braddock to serve three-year terms to expire April 30, 2019; Alexandra Brewer, Joshua Jorgensen, and Lowell Wyse to fill unexpired terms to expire April 30, 2018; and reappointing Alyssa Illich to serve a three-year term to expire April 30, 2019.

**STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:**

Appointing and reappointing individuals to the Commission best aligns with the strategic priority policy related to fostering neighborhood, community, and economic development vitality and sustainability because the Commission oversees implementation of Tacoma’s Climate Action Plan as the City and community reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
