RECOMMENDATION SUMMARY:

The Public Works Department (PW) requests approval to increase CW2251475, to Convergint Technologies LLC, Renton, WA, by \$300,000, plus applicable taxes, budgeted from 5700 Facilities Fund, for continuation of projects such as facility technology integration and security system services for new and existing systems in the facilities maintained by PW. This increase will bring the contract to a cumulative total of \$775,000, plus applicable taxes.

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

- Assure outstanding stewardship of the natural and built environment.
- Encourage and promote an efficient and effective government, which is fiscally sustainable and guided by engaged residents.

The contract allows PW to enhance the City's existing buildings with needed access and security improvements. Increasing the contract limit will be the most fiscally responsible use of public funds.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Tacoma issued a Citywide contract for facility technology integration and security system services to Convergint Technologies LLC through a competitively solicited and publicly awarded contract with Omnia Partners (R220702) effective April 1, 2022, which expires March 31, 2025. PW issued a sub-agreement, Contract No. CW2251475, for use to support facility access control, fire alarm maintenance, and security systems.

ISSUE: PW requests a contract limit increase to continue working on the implementation of the Fire Department access control initiative as well as support maintenance on existing systems maintained by the Facilities Management Division throughout the City of Tacoma.

ALTERNATIVES: The alternative would be to not increase the contract amount, post a Request for Qualifications for other firms to be able submit their qualifications and execute a similar contract for similar services. This would cause a delay in the maintenance and installation throughout City of Tacoma facilities and may result in higher pricing.

COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION:

Omnia Partners Request for Proposals (RFP) Specification No. 22-07 was opened January 11, 2022. Three submittals were received. Three companies were awarded contracts in Region four. On April 1, 2022, Convergint Technologies LLC was awarded a Citywide contract and chosen to be the City's regional vendor.

CONTRACT HISTORY:

- Effective April 1, 2022, the City of Tacoma executed a sub-agreement, Contract No. CW2251475, with Convergint Technologies, LLC, in the amount of \$150,000, plus applicable taxes, for an initial contract period of three years expiring on March 31, 2025, with the option to renew for two additional one-year periods through March 31, 2027.
- Effective February 28, 2023, Amendment No. 1 was executed to increase the compensation by \$325,000 for a new not to exceed amount of \$475,000.
- Effective June 1, 2023, Amendment No. 2 was executed to update contract language regarding contract value by removing the not to exceed amount and imposing the requirement that individual purchases exceeding \$500,000 require governing body approval, and to clarify the requirement for bonds.
- Amendment No. 3 requests an increase of \$300,000, for continuation of projects such as
 facility technology integration and security system services for new and existing systems
 in the facilities maintained by PW. This increase will bring the contract to a cumulative
 total of \$775,000, plus applicable taxes.

- Convergint Technologies LLC agrees to comply with all applicable standards, orders or regulations issued pursuant to the Clean Air Act, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 7401 et seq. 2.
- Convergint Technologies LLC agrees to comply with all applicable standards, orders, or regulations issued pursuant to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended, 33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq.
- Convergint Technologies LLC agrees to report each violation to the City and understands and agrees that the City will, in turn, report each violation as required to assure notification to the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and the appropriate Environmental Protection Agency Regional Office.
