Homelessness

Sheltering (*Not competing*)

- Goal: Sustain shelter capacity through a diversity of shelter models.

Complementary Services

- Goal: Provide households access to a continuum of tailored supports to prevent and end homelessness.

Housing Services and Interventions

- Goal: Increase access to permanent, stable housing in order to end the cycle of homelessness.

Encampment Response

- Goal: Increase access to resources through outreach and address public health and safety concerns.

DEPARTMENT PRIORITIES (cont.)

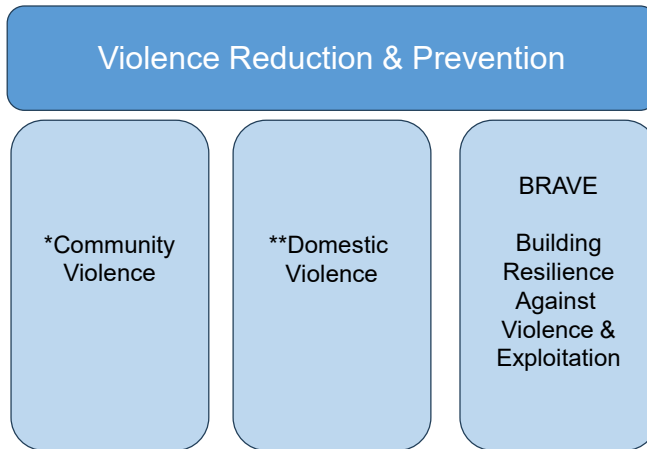


Violence Reduction & Prevention
