SUMMARY:

Appointing the following individuals to the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority Board:

- Appointing Meredith Neal to the “Contractor Rep.” designation to serve a two-year term, retroactive to March 1, 2019, to expire February 28, 2021.
- Appointing Terri Scott to the “Lender Rep.” designation to fill an unexpired term to expire February 29, 2020, followed by a two-year term to expire February 28, 2022.
- Appointing Kimber Starr to the “Realtor Rep.” designation to fill an unexpired term to expire February 29, 2020, followed by a two-year term to expire February 28, 2022.

COUNCIL SPONSORS:

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

Appointing individuals to the Board best aligns with the strategic policy priority related to fostering neighborhood, community, and economic development vitality and sustainability because the Board administers loans to a variety of clients such as low-income families who need help in buying or repairing their homes, owners who provide multi-family housing to low-income families, businesses which create jobs or rehabilitate older, blighted buildings, and non-profit organizations that provide services to our community.

BACKGROUND:

At the May 9, 2019 meeting, the Community Vitality and Safety Committee interviewed applicants and recommended the appointment of the individuals listed above.

ISSUE:

Three positions need to be filled on the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority Board.
