Pay for Performance Update

Director Gaines made introductory remarks. Joy St. Germain, Human Resources Director, Mary McDougal, Human Resources Manager, and Pat Shannon of Mercer Company, conducted the presentation. The rationale behind a pay for performance system was outlined. Pay for performance supports a performance culture and maintains market competition. Market trends, including market prevalence, best practices, pros and cons, of pay for performance programs were detailed. Selected public sector examples were shared. There was then an overview of pay for performance program design features.

Tacoma Power: Energy Risk Management Update

Cam LeHouillier, Energy Risk Manager, shared a graphical representation of wholesale revenue components. Mr. LeHouiller then detailed the hedging results for the second quarter of 2013, the biennium wholesale revenues, and financially settled hedges.
