1. 15-0616 Jail Services for Incarceration of City of Tacoma Misdemeanants
[Mark Lauzier, City Manager's Office]

At approximately 10:07 a.m., Mark Lauzier, Assistant City Manager, reviewed jail services agreements for incarceration of City of Tacoma misdemeanants, including an overview of current contracts, background, current issues, a financial summary, recommendations, and next steps. Discussion ensued regarding budget, understaffing, number of inmates, presentence inmates, performance metrics, release times, accommodations, transport options, short term arrests, and release parameters. Council Member Campbell requested to further discuss release parameters during monthly meetings. Discussion continued regarding mental health, per-day charges, and escort costs.
