Community Issues and Considerations

- Funding Vehicle Replacement:
 - Approximately 40% 50% of the overall fleet (~600 assets) are past due for replacement (~\$70M-\$80M)
- Deferred Repair and Replacement Program for GG Facilities
 - Continued investment is essential to maintain facilities and ensure ongoing critical services to residents
- Facilities Capital Investment Strategy for GG Facilities
 - A significant investment is needed in order to meet the current and future level-of-service needs of the community

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2025-2026 Services and Major Initiatives Facilities and Fleet

- Enhance Real Property Services (+2 FTE, \$533k)
 - Increase level of service to meet current and future demand for Home in Tacoma and permit review timeline changes in Real Property Services
- Fleet Replacements (\$3.7M ongoing in baseline for TPD)
 - Work towards eliminating the backlog while expanding electric vehicles and alternative fuels where appropriate
- Continue the Deferred Repair and Replacement Program (\$6.8M ongoing in baseline)
 - Improve the overall condition of General Government non-utility, nonenterprise City Facilities
- Implementation of Tacoma Fire Department Levy Priorities 25-2026 CITY OF TACOMA
