Economic Development Framework Strategic Plan (Ricardo Noguera, Director, Community and Economic Development)

At approximately 10:04 a.m., Ricardo Noguera, Community and Economic Development, provided an overview on the Economic Development Strategic Framework and Action Plan, including marketing, Tacoma's economic development partners, 2014-2015 key accomplishments, foreign direct investments, new multi-family development projects, historic restoration and adaptive reuse.

Council Member McCarthy arrived here, at 10:17 a.m.

Mayor Strickland requested that Mr. Noguera review the first few slides of the presentation for Council Member McCarthy. Mr. Noguera stated in 2013 the Economic Development Committee launched the Economic Development Framework Strategic Plan. He stated the plan is a five year plan and the focus is on eight different areas. He discussed the focus areas, accomplishments, foreign investments, multi-family developments, historic preservation, arts and cultural activities, industrial and port activities, downtown office recruitment, retention and expansion, small business loans and facade loans, neighborhood revitalization activities, other miscellaneous activities and concluded by discussing projections for 2016-2017, including downtown office recruitment and development, the Brewery and Dome Districts, adaptive reuse and historic preservation, foreign district investment, multi-family developments, industrial and port activities, neighborhood business district revitalization activities, local recruitment for office development, partnerships with public agencies, development along the Foss Waterway, and Neighborhood Business District activities for 2016.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding Section 8 housing, Ram restaurant and brewery purchase, marketing, infrastructure, remediation challenges, the lease of Rite Aid, lease to own, Space Works, support of the plan, recruiting, marketing, floor plans, tenant improvement, lease rates, investments, modern office space, City assistance programs, incentives, reduction of permit fees, and focusing on current projects before new projects, and the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority.
