SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

Tacoma Rail requests re-authorization of Grant Agreement RRB-1311 from the Washington State Department of Transportation for \$4,950,000 associated with the acquisition of two zero emission locomotives and installation of the associated on-site charging infrastructure.

BACKGROUND: Originally approved with Resolutions U-11433 and 41345 in January 2024, TPU-Rail requests Council reapprove Grant Agreement RRB-1311 on account WSDOT staff updated the language in Section 14.5 Nondiscrimination, to be consistent with changes made to RCW 49.60.530 in the 2023 State Legislative Cycle. Additionally, WSDOT staff refined the language in Section 36 related to Climate Commitment Act branding requirements. TPU-Rail staff were notified of these required changes to the Agreement after Council approval was obtained on January 23, 2024.

Funding level and other provisions of the Agreement remain unchanged. Staff believe it's prudent to seek reauthorization based on the language in Section 2 of Resolution 41345, recognizing the document has changed from the version on file in the office of the City Clerk at the time of Council's approval on January 23, 2024.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ CUSTOMER RESEARCH:

The project will improve air quality by reducing diesel exhaust emissions in the Port area as well as for residents in identified environmental health disparities areas.
