#### **SUMMARY:**

Appointing Felicity Waldron to the "At-Large No. 3" position on the Transportation Commission to fill an unexpired term, to expire August 31, 2027.

### STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

Appointing individuals to the Transportation Commission (Commission) best aligns with the strategic priority policy related to planning for and improving public infrastructure that meets the transportation needs of all Tacoma residents and visitors because the Commission advises the City Council on transportation-related matters.

### **BACKGROUND:**

At the August 13, 2025, Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee meeting, the Committee conducted interviews and at the September 10, 2025, meeting the Committee recommended the appointment of the individual listed above, to fill an unexpired term which was vacated by Commissioner Spencer on August 20, 2025.

### **ISSUE:**

A position needs to be filled on the Transportation Commission.

The Commission would continue to operate without full membership.
