



RESOLUTION NO. 40478

1 A RESOLUTION relating to grant funding; ratifying the Interlocal Cooperative
2 Agreement, retroactive to January 25, 2018; and authorizing the execution
3 of an Amended and Restated Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with
4 participating agencies for the receipt of \$10,000, for deposit into the Police
5 Special Revenue Fund, for use in the distribution of funds and allocation of
6 resources pursuant to the 2018 Washington Auto Theft Prevention Grant
7 Award, to respond to, prevent, and investigate auto theft and related crimes.

8 WHEREAS local law enforcement entities recognized a need for proactive
9 regional cooperation to address issues created by auto theft within the region,
10 determined that a concentrated and coordinated effort is critical to an effective
11 statewide response to vehicle theft, and have agreed to provide mutual aid and
12 share resources as necessary, and

13 WHEREAS, effective January 25, 2018, pursuant to Chapters 10.93 and
14 39.34 of the Revised Code of Washington, the Washington State Patrol; Pierce
15 County Sheriff's Department; King County Prosecutor's Office; and municipalities of
16 Auburn, Bonney Lake, Federal Way, Lakewood, Tacoma, and Tukwila entered into
17 an Interlocal Cooperative Agreement ("Agreement") to establish and maintain a
18 multi-jurisdictional team to effectively investigate and enforce laws relating to auto
19 theft, and

20 WHEREAS the original Agreement was signed by the parties, but did not
21 come before the City Council, and

22 WHEREAS the parties desire to amend the Agreement to add the
23 municipalities of Puyallup and Redmond and the Port of Seattle to the agreement,

WHEREAS the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement will be used for the distribution of funds and allocation of resources pursuant to the 2018 Washington Auto Theft Prevention Grant Award, to respond to, prevent, and investigate auto theft and related crimes, and

WHEREAS the City will receive \$10,000, for deposit into the Police Special Revenue Fund, to be used for this purpose; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the existing Interlocal Cooperative Agreement is hereby ratified, retroactive to January 25, 2018.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Amended and Restated Interlocal Cooperative Agreement with participating agencies for the receipt of \$10,000, for deposit into the Police Special Revenue Fund, for use in the distribution of funds and allocation of resources pursuant to the 2018 Washington Auto Theft Prevention Grant Award, to respond to, prevent, and investigate auto theft and related crimes, said agreement to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 3. That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to take and execute any additional measures or documents that may be necessary to



1 complete this transaction which are consistent with the approved form of
2 documents attached to this Resolution, and the intent of this Resolution.
