Tacoma Power: Cowlitz River Project Downstream Fish Collection

Pat McCarty, Generation Manager, provided a detailed overview of the Cowlitz Project. Downstream fish collection activities from 2002 – 2012 were detailed. Downstream fish passage team alternatives analysis was summarized. The proposed fish collection facility at Cowlitz Falls and the long-term agreement with Tacoma Power, Lewis County Public Utility District and the Bonneville Power Administration were detailed. Matt Bleich, fisheries Biologist, spoke to adaptive management and detailed downstream collection goals vs. current collection, biological basis for design and location, and adaptability of design. The project schedule, which has a completion date of April 2017, was reviewed.
