

## **RESOLUTION NO. 39997**

A RESOLUTION related to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Click! Unit, effective retroactive to January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2018.

WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and the administration, and

WHEREAS this resolution allows for the execution of the proposed twoyear Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the City and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Click! Unit ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented by said Union, and

WHEREAS the bargaining unit consists of approximately 59 budgeted, full-time equivalent positions within Tacoma Public Utilities, and

WHEREAS the proposed CBA provides for a 2 percent wage increase, effective retroactive to January 1, 2017; and a 3 percent wage increase, retroactive to January 1, 2018, and

WHEREAS, additionally, an employee who was active as of the date of ratification of the CBA on January 22, 2018, and in a frozen wage rate, will receive a one-time lump sum payment of \$1,000 upon ratification of the CBA, and another one-time lump sum payment of \$1,000 if the employee's wages remain frozen after the 2018 wage increase is applied, and

WHEREAS other changes to the CBA include the inclusion of language from several letters of agreement that have been incorporated into the body of



 the CBA, and the addition of standard language regarding time off and benefits to Appendix B, and

WHEREAS the City and Union recognize there are pending legal challenges to the Click! Network's continued operations which may be resolved through court order or settlement, that could have significant impacts on the Click! organization; the City and Union both agree to reopen the CBA in order to negotiate the implementation of any required changes that may be necessary due to court order or settlement agreement, and

WHEREAS it appears in the best interests of the City that the proposed CBA negotiated by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Click! Unit, effective retroactive to January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2018, said documents to be
