RESOLUTION NO. 38896

A RESOLUTION related to the purchase of materials, supplies or equipment, and the furnishing of services; authorizing the waiver of competitive procurement procedures due to sole source availability, as deemed in the best interests of the City; authorizing the increase of the existing contract with Agilent Technologies, in the amount of \$45,309.27, plus sales tax, for a cumulative total of \$201,513.33, plus sales tax, budgeted from the Fire Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund, for accessory equipment, installation, training and consulting services to assist the Fire Department to operate a portable gas chromatograph/mass spectrometer.

WHEREAS the City has complied with all applicable laws and processes governing the acquisition of those supplies, and/or the procurement of those services, inclusive of public works, as is shown by the attached Exhibit "A," incorporated herein as though fully set forth, and

WHEREAS the Board of Contracts and Awards has concurred with the recommendation for award as set forth in Exhibit "A"; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Tacoma concurs with the Board of Contracts and Awards to adopt the recommendation for award as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A," and authorizes the waiver of competitive procurement procedures due to sole source availability, as deemed in the best interests of the City.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to increase the existing contract with Agilent Technologies, in the amount of \$45,309.27, plus sales tax, for a cumulative total of \$201,513.33, plus sales tax, budgeted from the Fire Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund, for accessory equipment, installation, training and consulting services to assist the Fire
