RESOLUTION NO. 39617

A RESOLUTION relating to labor negotiations; authorizing the execution of Amendment No. 3 to the Professional Services Contract with Summit Law Group, in the amount of \$300,000, for a cumulative contract amount of \$700,000, budgeted from the General Fund, for labor negotiation services for the City of Tacoma, on behalf of the Human Resources Director.

WHEREAS, in August 2013, the City entered into a Professional Services
Contract with Summit Law Group ("Summit"), in the amount of \$50,000, to serve
as Chief Negotiator, in partnership with the City's Management Team and
Human Resources Director and staff, to bargain and complete contract
negotiations or mediation related to the Joint Labor contract, and

WHEREAS the need for bargaining and negotiation services increased and continued, and, effective December 23, 2013, the parties entered into Amendment No. 1 to the contract, in the amount of \$150,000, for a maximum contract amount of \$200,000, and extended the term of the contract to February 1, 2015, and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the continuing need for bargaining and negotiation services on July 28, 2015, pursuant to Resolution No. 39248, the City Council authorized Amendment No. 2 to the contract, in the amount of \$200,000, for a maximum contract amount of \$400,000, and to extend the term of the contract to December 31, 2018, and

WHEREAS, in order to accommodate the City's ongoing need for these services, the parties wish to enter into Amendment No. 3 to the contract to increase the maximum compensation thereunder by \$300,000, for a new

maximum compensation of \$700,000, to continue said services through December 31, 2018; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to enter into Amendment No. 3 to the Professional Services Contract with Summit Law Group, in the amount of \$300,000 for a cumulative contract amount of \$700,000, budgeted from the General Fund, through December 31, 2018, for the purpose of serving as labor negotiator for the City of Tacoma, on behalf of the Human Resources Director, to bargain and complete contract negotiations or mediation, and to advise on labor negotiation matters as directed by the City, said amendment to be substantially in the form of the proposed document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
