SUMMARY:

Appointing and reappointing the following individuals to the Tacoma Area Commission on Disabilities:

- Appointing Lukas Barfield to fill an unexpired term to expire August 31, 2021.
- Appointing Sherelle Rogers to fill an unexpired term to expire August 31, 2020, followed by a three-year term to expire August 31, 2023.
- Appointing Richard Smaby to fill an unexpired term to expire August 31, 2019, followed by a three-year term to expire August 31, 2022.
- Reappointing Lori Allison to serve a three-year term to expire August 31, 2022.
- Reappointing Anthony Caldwell to serve a three-year term to expire August 31, 2022.

Appointing individuals to the Commission best aligns with the strategic priority policy related to encouraging and promoting an open, effective, results-oriented organization by ensuring the Tacoma Area Commission on Disabilities has full membership and can continue to advise the City Council in policy making, partner with the community to bring awareness of issues that affect individuals with disabilities, participate on committees, educate the public about disability issues, and serve as a resource for City staff.

Positions need to be filled on the Tacoma Area Commission on Disabilities.
