SUMMARY:
 The Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee will interview and may recommend up to three applicants to the full City Council for appointment or reappointment to the Landmarks Preservation Commission. Below is a list of the applicants:

BACKGROUND:
 The Landmarks Preservation Commission oversees the establishment and regulation of landmarks, local historic districts, proposed name changes for public facilities, and certain property tax incentives. The Commission consists of 11 members comprised of three architects, four individuals with professional expertise in preservation related fields, and four interested residents. Non-voting ex-officio members may be appointed to represent property and business owners within Tacoma's historic districts.

ISSUE:
 Positions need to be filled on the Commission.

ALTERNATIVES:
 The Commission will continue to operate without full membership.

FISCAL IMPACT:
 There is no fiscal impact.



RECOMMENDATION:

Staff requests that the Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee recommend the appointment or reappointment of up to three applicants to the Landmarks Preservation Commission, which would be forwarded to the full City Council on November 29, 2022.
