



Background

- City Council Resolution No. 39642 passed on Jan 21, 2017
- Alignment with Equity and Empowerment Goals, and Welcoming Cities and Counties Initiatives
- Convened community partners and surveyed over 500 I&R residents

Proposed Actions


1. City of Tacoma Commission on Immigrant and Refugee Affairs

Full representation ~\$440k

OR

Partial Representation ~\$220k



What Could a Tacoma Families ILDF Look Like?

- Request for Proposals (RFP)
- Commitment
 - Monetary
 - Tacoma Families
 - Ongoing nature of cases



What Would a Tacoma Families ILDF Achieve?

Two Systems of Justice: Does This Seem Fair?		
 Criminal Justice System	Immigration Justice System	
Miranda Warning	YES.	NO. Immigrants receive more limited warnings, but only <i>after</i> being interrogated.
Access to a Lawyer	YES. Even if you can't afford one.	NO. Unless you can afford one yourself.
Right to a Bail Hearing	YES.	NO. Many immigrants are subject to "mandatory detention" and denied a hearing to make their case for bond.
Right to a Speedy Trial	YES.	NO. Some immigrants remain detained for months and even years awaiting resolutions of their cases.
Illegally Obtained Evidence Thrown Out	YES.	NO. Almost all evidence obtained - legally or not - is admissible.
Right to Trial Before Jury	YES.	NO. Only before a judge or adjudicator. And the majority of immigrants have no right to even see a judge.

Language Access


Language Spoken At Home

Tacoma Washington






