Briefing Items

2. 14-1277 City Charter Amendment Next Steps [Elizabeth Pauli, City Attorney]

At approximately 4:32 p.m., Elizabeth Pauli, City Attorney, stated voters passed ten of the twelve ballot measures transmitted by the Council for the Special Municipal Election of November 2014 to amend the City Charter in which six will be implemented by updating the Charter, and four will need Council action for implementation. She then reviewed the four amendments that will need further Council action which relate to Council authority to confirm the appointment of department heads, confirmation and reappointment of the Director of Utilities, adding requirements for the Landmarks Preservation Commission, and the mayoral appointments for the

Citizen Commission on Elected Salaries.

Bryan Flint, Public Utility Board, reviewed the Board's current process for annually evaluating the Director of Utilities. Discussion ensued throughout regarding the intent of confirming appointments, the evaluation process by the Public Utility Board, creation of an Executive Committee, vetting language to reflect accountability in the Charter through Study Session or Committee of the Whole, and the Pierce County Auditor's lot process. Council Member Campbell requested staff determine if the Auditor charges for their lot process services, and if they review whether the candidates have any conflict of interests with the City. Discussion continued regarding the Citizen Commission on Elected Salaries, including the lot process, Council district representation, timeframe for Commission selection, the Commission's scope of work and jurisdiction to change compensation, and the ordinance process.
