



## RESOLUTION NO. 40867

1 A RESOLUTION setting Tuesday, November 30, 2021, upon completion of  
2 Regular Agenda Items, no earlier than 5:15 p.m., as the date for a public  
3 hearing by the City Council on the proposed amendments to the 2021-2022  
4 Annual Action Plan for Housing, Community, and Economic Development  
5 projects.

6 WHEREAS, each year, the City submits an Annual Action Plan ("Plan") to  
7 the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") to fulfill the  
8 requirements associated with receipt of grant funding, in order to ensure that the  
9 City receives federal funds to manage its housing, community and economic  
10 development, neighborhood improvement, homeless assistance and social service  
11 programs, and

12 WHEREAS the Plan outlines the City's use of Community Development  
13 Block Grant ("CDBG"), HOME Investment Partnership ("HOME"), and Emergency  
14 Solutions Grant ("ESG") funds, and

15 WHEREAS the original Annual Action Plan, approved by the City Council on  
16 May 11, 2021, pursuant to Resolution No. 40782, provided that CDBG Public  
17 Services and ESG funding would be allocated as follows: (1) approximately  
18 50 percent funding will be allocated to extend contracts with providers receiving  
19 2020-2021 CDBG Public Services and ESG funding for an additional six months,  
20 for the period of July 1, 2021, through December 31, 2021; and (2) the remaining  
21 50 percent funding would be later allocated for expenditures from January 1, 2022,  
22 through June 30, 2022, and  
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WHEREAS staff has worked with the Human Services Commission to determine the allocation of remaining CDBG Public Services funding in the amount of \$194,464, and ESG funding in the amount of \$98,615, as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A," and

WHEREAS the proposed recommendations were presented to the Human Services Commission on October 13, 2021; the Pierce County Continuum of Care on October 20, 2021; and the Community Vitality and Safety Committee on October 28, 2021, and

WHEREAS, prior to the public hearing, beginning on November 5, 2021, and ending on December 7, 2021, the City will publish a legal ad in The News Tribune notifying the public of the opportunity to make verbal comment on the proposed amendment; Now, Therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:**

Section 1. That Tuesday, November 30, 2021, upon completion of the Regular Agenda Items, no earlier than 5:15 p.m., is hereby fixed as the time, and the City Council Chambers on the First Floor of the Tacoma Municipal Building, 747 Market Street, Tacoma, Washington, unless the Governor's proclamation limiting in-person meetings is still in effect and then a call in option will be provided, as the place when and where a public hearing shall be held on the recommendations of the Community and Economic Development Department for the City's proposed amendments to the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan for Housing, Community, and Economic Development projects.



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Section 2. That the City Clerk shall give proper notice of the time and place of said hearing.
