

## **RESOLUTION NO. 41250**

A RESOLUTION related to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and the Professional and Technical Employees, Local 17 (PROTEC17), retroactive to January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2026.

WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and the administration, and

WHEREAS this resolution allows for the execution of a four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the City and the Professional and Technical Employees, Local 17 (PROTEC17) ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented by said Union, and

WHEREAS the bargaining unit consists of approximately 281 budgeted, full-time equivalent ("FTE") positions, and

WHEREAS the CBA will provide for a general wage increase of 2.5 percent, retroactive to January 1, 2023, with market-based wage adjustments by classification of between 2 percent and 10 percent, and

WHEREAS the CBA will provide for general wage increases of 2.75 percent, effective January 1, 2024, with market-based wage adjustments by classification of between 2 percent and 10 percent, and

WHEREAS the CBA will provide for a general wage increase of 2.75 percent, effective January 1, 2025, and

WHEREAS the CBA will provide a general wage increase of 3 percent, effective January 1, 2026, and



WHEREAS the CBA was considered and approved by the Public Utility Board at its meeting of July 12, 2023, and

WHEREAS it appears in the best interests of the City that the CBA negotiated by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and the Professional and Technical Employees Local 17 (PROTEC17), effective retroactive to January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2026, said document to be substantially in the form of the agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk.
