1. <u>15-1085</u> Pedestrian Crossing Improvements Summary

At approximately 12:03 p.m., Kurtis Kingsolver, Public Works Director, introduced Mark D'Andrea, Project Manager, who presented an overview of the pedestrian crossing improvement project, including project goals, outreach, site selection, site prioritization, contracting, project outcomes and the site selected for the second phase of the project.

Discussion ensued regarding support for the project, process, school zones, pedestrian safety, and storm damage from rainfall on October 10, 2015.

2. <u>15-1086</u> Outreach on the Hazards of Aluminum Wiring

At approximately 12:30 p.m., Tory Green, Deputy Chief, Pat McElligott, Assistant Chief and Fire Marshall, and Ryan Erickson, Fire Code Official, reviewed the hazards of aluminum wiring, including background, potential structures that may contain aluminum wiring, why aluminum wiring may be a problem, how to know if you have aluminum wiring, examples of what aluminum wiring may look like, warning signs, how to fix aluminum wiring, outreach, the web page created to make citizens more aware of aluminum wiring risks, and next steps.

Discussion ensued regarding the number of electrical fires per year, utility bill insert, and homeowners who would like to repair their own wiring.
