1 A RESOLUTION related to the purchase of materials, supplies or equipment, and  
2 the furnishing of services; authorizing the execution of a contract with  
3 Columbia Ford Lincoln, in the amount of \$414,885, plus applicable sales  
4 tax, budgeted from the General Fund, to purchase 15 current model Ford  
Police Interceptor utility vehicles pursuant to the terms of State of  
Washington Contract No. 03611.

**SUBJECT:** Purchase New Ford Vehicles  
 Budgeted from Police General Fund 0010  
 State of Washington Contract No. 03611

**RECOMMENDATION:** Public Works, Facilities Management, Fleet Services on behalf of the Tacoma Police Department, recommends a contract in the amount of \$414,885, plus applicable sales tax, be awarded to **Columbia Ford Lincoln, Longview, WA**, for the purchase of 15 current model Ford Police Interceptor utility vehicles per the terms of the State of Washington Contract No. 03611.

**EXPLANATION:** The Ford Police Interceptor utility vehicles will replace patrol vehicles that have reached the end of their life-cycle and are no longer feasible to maintain. The surplus vehicles will be disposed of through a dealer's auction.

**SUSTAINABILITY:** The State of Washington models sustainable business practices that contribute to the long-term protection and enhancement of our environment, our economy and the health of current and future generations. The Ford Interceptor Utility model was selected to replace our current Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor fleet which is no longer produced by the Ford automobile manufacturer. The standard V6 engine is projected to get at least 20 percent better fuel efficiency than the 2011 Crown Victoria Police Interceptor.

**COMPETITIVE BIDDING:** The State of Washington Contract No. 03611 was competitively bid and includes the vehicles to be purchased. The contract is valid through October 31, 2013. Through an interlocal cooperative purchasing agreement the City of Tacoma will purchase the needed vehicles at the prices, term, and conditions of the state contract. The ability to participate in cooperative purchasing through the State Contract provides the City increased savings by pooling resources to leverage the market through volume discounts. Columbia Ford Lincoln's volume purchasing also affords the City the guarantee that the vehicles will be delivered and ready for retrofits timely and effectively.

**CONTRACT HISTORY:** New contract.

**FUNDING:** Funds are budgeted from Police General Fund 0010. Funding beyond the current biennium is subject to the future availability of funds.
