1. Call to Order; Roll Call

5. Program Updates

Staff

Clarissa Gines shared updates on the ending of the 2022-23, and the start of the 2023-24 funding years. In the past month, lots of staff support was provided to funded organizations to help with reporting and contracting. She also provided information on the rescheduled Kick-Off Convening and invited TCAB members to attend.

Lisa Jaret then informed TCAB of the various staffing transitions happening within the Office of Arts & Cultural Vitality, and shared an update on TCAB appointments.

6. TCAB Committees & Operations

Chair Cooks shared the list of TCAB committees, the members who sit on each of those committees, and quick updates on whether those committees met or not in the past month.

7. Discussion: Reauthorization

Vice Chair Bert and TCAB member Allison Campbell (who sit on the TCAB Reauthorization Committee), covered highlights on where the discussion is so far regarding reauthorization for Tacoma Creates. TCAB members also had an opportunity to read through language that explains the councilmanic option that is being considered. Lisa Jaret talked about next steps in the process, including scheduling roundtable sessions for Tacoma Creates funded organizations and other community engagement opportunities.

8. Discussion: Division Manager Recruiting

Lisa Jaret introduced Randy Engstrom, a consultant with Third Way Creative, who presented information on the Office of Arts & Cultural Vitality's recruitment process for a new Division Manager. Community and Economic Development Director Jeff Robinson was also available to answer any questions and offer additional information.

Lisa Jaret introduced Jasmine Brown, Artscapes Coordinator for Spaceworks Tacoma, and Klair Ethridge, Executive Director of Tacoma Urban Performing Arts Center, before they presented about the work their organizations provide, and how Tacoma Creates is supporting this work.

Chair Cooks facilitated questions and comments at the end of the presentations. Appreciation was shared from TCAB members.

10. OACV Staff Reports

Clarissa Gines provided information on upcoming events happening during Tacoma Arts Month, which include the Kaleidoscope opening party, Tacoma Studio Tours, and Arts at the Armory.

11. Comments from TCAB
