RESOLUTION NO. 37220

A RESOLUTION related to the City's Commute Trip Reduction ("CTR") Plan; approving the proposed plan and the proposed Growth and Transportation Efficiency Center Program; and submitting both to the Puget Sound Regional Council and the Washington State CTR Board for review and approval.

WHEREAS, in 2006, the Washington State Legislature passed the Commute Trip Reduction ("CTR") Efficiency Act ("Act"), which is a revision to the 1991 CTR law and sets forth new planning requirements and higher goals for reducing single-occupant vehicle ("SOV") trips and vehicle miles traveled ("VMT") by affected employees, and

WHEREAS the Act requires local jurisdictions to develop CTR plans to identify strategies for achieving the goals and also encourages local jurisdictions to designate areas of dense employment and residential development as Growth and Transportation Efficiency Centers ("GTEC") where more aggressive strategies can be applied to achieve a greater reduction of SOV trips and VMT, thus reducing demand on the state and local transportation systems, and

WHEREAS the proposed City of Tacoma Commute Trip Reduction Plan has been developed pursuant to the Act, and

WHEREAS the proposed CTR Plan is a planning document and provides a rational basis for a discussion by the City Council on the level of funding commitment necessary to achieve the state-mandated CTR goals, and
