



RESOLUTION NO. 39683

1 A RESOLUTION relating to the Tacoma Training and Employment Program;
2 authorizing the execution of an agreement with South Sound Outreach
3 Services, d.b.a. Sound Outreach, in the amount of \$331,876, budgeted
4 from the Tacoma Training and Employment Program Fund, for case
5 management and other support services relating to the Tacoma Training
6 and Employment Program, for the period of January 1, 2017, through
7 December 31, 2018.

8 WHEREAS the Tacoma Training and Employment Program ("Program")
9 focuses resources to promote the development of a trained workforce, particularly
10 in the building and construction trades and technical and career fields, and

12 WHEREAS key components of the Program are employment readiness
13 training, case management services, participant support services, participation in
14 a pre-apprenticeship training program ("TOOL Center"), job placement assistance,
15 and third-party evaluation, and

17 WHEREAS recruitment efforts focus on, but are not limited to, young
18 adults, ages 18-24, who are residents of the Lincoln District and Community
19 Empowerment Zone, women, minorities, those transitioning from public benefits,
20 those with limited English-speaking abilities, and young adults involved in other
21 City-funded programs or initiatives, and

23 WHEREAS, as part of the TTEP collaboration, South Sound Outreach
24 Services, d.b.a. Sound Outreach ("Sound Outreach"), will provide case
25 management and other support services to participants on an as-needed basis,
26 including assistance with acquiring tools, clothing, and transportation; and will
provide drug screening prior to participants' being admitted to TOOL Center



training, as well employment coaching and financial empowerment services post-
