Mayor Woodards called the study session to order at 12:08 p.m.

Briefing Items

1. [20-0547](#) Budget Update

At approximately 12:10 p.m., Katie Johnston, Budget Officer, Finance, presented the budget update for the second quarter of 2020, including an agenda; economic conditions; risks; revenue, expenses, and other fund trends for the second quarter of the 2020 budget; the General Fund forecast for 2020-2022; revised General Fund revenue projections for 2021-2022; property tax; sales tax; business tax; utility tax; an overall revenue summary; updated gap projections for 2020 and 2021-2022; 2021-2022 General Fund expense projection; and next steps.

Discussion ensued regarding levies, sales tax, the projected gap for 2020-2022, status of the reserve fund, amount saved through program and project cuts, incorporating community feedback and City Council priorities into budget considerations, future surveys, continuing outreach, how to reach underrepresented communities, and identifying areas eligible for budget cuts.

2. [20-0548](#) Systems Transformation Update

At approximately 1:15 p.m., City Manager Elizabeth Pauli presented the systems transformation update, including new items, the systems transformation update table, the next steps timeline, and the draft transformation timeline.

Discussion ensued regarding upcoming events, public safety, and police presence in the community.
