

RESOLUTION NO. 41428

A RESOLUTION relating to community, economic development, and neighborhood and community services; authorizing the acceptance of a grant from the Washington State Department of Commerce, in the amount of \$1,000,000, and accepting and depositing said sum into the Special Revenue Fund, for down payment assistance; and the execution of an increase to the agreement with the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority, in the amount of \$1,000,000, for a total amount of \$2,500,000, to increase funding for the homebuyer education and first-time homebuyer down payment assistance program.

WHEREAS in 2023, the City of Tacoma ("City") was awarded \$1,000,000, in grant funding from the Washington State Department of Commerce for homebuyer down payment assistance, and

WHEREAS the City also has \$500,000 budgeted for homebuyer down payment assistance and homebuyer education programs, and

WHEREAS the department's recommendation is based on a homeownership disparities study that was commissioned by the City Council and completed in 2021, and

WHEREAS the study evidenced that systemic policies and practices by government institutions had disproportionately impacted Black households, creating a system that was less likely to allow them to become homeowners compared to white households, and

WHEREAS the study also identified that the current type of homebuyer programs funded by the City were not substantially utilized by Black households and did little to remove the barriers they often experience when trying to purchase a home, and



WHEREAS the study further identified the need for more down payment assistance options at higher amounts to help bridge the gap between home prices and a mortgage that is affordable, and

WHEREAS the City was awarded additional funds in the amount of \$1,000,000, and

WHEREAS the City's Community and Economic Development

Department recommends an agreement with the Washington State Department of Commerce, in the amount of \$1,000,000 for down payment assistance, and an amendment to the contract with the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority for the total amount of \$2,500,000, through November 1, 2050, for homebuyer education and first-time homebuyer down payment assistance, and

WHEREAS, under the grant process guidelines, the City Council must approve acceptance of grant funding; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to accept grant funding from the Washington State Department of Commerce in the amount of \$1,000,000, for deposit into the Special Revenue Fund, for the purpose of providing homebuyer education and first-time homebuyer down payment assistance.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Washington State Department of Commerce for the funding accepted pursuant to Section 1, and an increase to the agreement with the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority, in the amount of



\$1,000,000, for a total amount of \$2,500,000, to increase funding for the homebuyer education and first-time homebuyer down payment assistance program, said documents to be substantially in the form of the proposed grant agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk.
