RESOLUTION NO. 41728

A RESOLUTION relating to the Department of Public Utilities, Water Division; (d.b.a. "Tacoma Water"), authorizing the execution of an interlocal agreement with various local governments within the Water Resource Inventory Area 9, requiring annual funding amount of \$26,514, budgeted from the Water Fund, to support watershed-based salmon recovery in the Green River, Duwamish River and Central Puget Sound Watersheds, through December 31, 2035.

WHEREAS the City of Tacoma, Department of Public Utilities, Water Division (d.b.a. "Tacoma Water"), desires to renew an interlocal cooperation agreement between multiple county and city governments and other interested public agencies, and tribes within the geographic planning area of the Water Resource Inventory Area 9 ("WRIA 9"), collectively, the WRIA 9 Agreement, and

WHEREAS the WRIA 9 serves as a lead entity for salmon recovery under the State of Washington's watershed-based framework for salmon recovery established under RCW 77.85, and is comprised of local, state and federal partners, non-profit organizations, business interests, and citizens, and

WHEREAS, the WRIA 9 is mandated to create a list of habitat projects, establish priorities for individual projects, define the sequence for project implementation, and submit these activities as the habitat project list, and

WHEREAS the WRIA 9 also identifies potential federal, state, local, and private funding sources, and

WHEREAS this is the third interlocal cooperation agreement between multiple counties and cities of King and Pierce Counties and other interested public agencies and tribes, and marks 25 years of advancing salmon recovery

efforts in the watersheds of Green River, Duwamish River, and Central Puget Sound, and

WHEREAS the proposed WRIA 9 agreement obligates Tacoma Water to provide \$26,514 annually to support the long-term watershed-based planning through December 31, 2035, and

WHEREAS, by adoption of Public Utility Board Resolution No. U-11544 on July 23, 2025, the proposed agreement was approved, pending confirmation from the City Council; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the request of the Department of Public Utilities,

Water Division (d.b.a. "Tacoma Water") to enter into an interlocal agreement with
various local governments within the Water Resource Inventory Area 9, requiring
an annual funding amount of \$26,514, budgeted from the Water Fund, to support
watershed-based salmon recovery in the Green River, Duwamish River and
Central Puget Sound Watersheds, through December 31, 2035, is hereby
approved.



Section 2. That the proper officers of the City of Tacoma are authorized to execute said agreement substantially in a form on file with the City Clerk and as approved by the City Attorney's Office.
