Briefing Items

1. <u>16-0214</u> Legislative Updates

At approximately 12:09 p.m., Randy Lewis, Government Relations Officer, provided an update on Washington State Legislature Senate bills (SB) and House bills (HB) related to City bills of interest, including the Pension Public Records Act (PRA) exemption (SB 6170), and a local 10 year property tax exemption (SB 6239).

Council Member Campbell arrived here, at 12:13 p.m.

Mr. Lewis continued providing updates including, an exemption for some body camera images from the PRA (HB 2362), extension of the .33 percent sales tax credit used by public facilities (HB 2296), extension of the Local Revitalization Financing program (SB 5109), and creation of a Business and Occupation tax task force (HB 2959). Mr. Lewis concluded by discussing budget issues, and upcoming dates.

Other Items of Interest

There were no other items of interest.

Committee Reports

Council Member Ibsen reported on ForeverGreen Trails formulating long range trail education and outreach plans. Council Member Ibsen stated that Northwest Innovation Works was present at the most recent Joint Municipal Action Committee meeting.

Council Member Lonergan reported on the Zoo Trek Authority, stating Point Defiance Zoo is collaborating with the Tacoma School District to build a Science and Math Institute classroom on the zoo grounds, scheduled to open Fall 2017. Council Member Lonergan gave an update on Northwest Trek's new Kids' Trek playground and picnic facility.
