

ORDINANCE NO. 28202

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Compensation Plan; amending Sections 1.12.355 and 1.12.640 of the Tacoma Municipal Code; and declaring the effective dates thereof to implement rates of pay and compensation for employees represented by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Clerical Unit.

WHEREAS the collective bargaining agreement with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Clerical Unit ("IBEW"), was approved pursuant to Resolution No. 38377, adopted on November 29, 2011, and covers approximately 197.2 budgeted, full-time equivalent positions, and

WHEREAS the agreement provides for a market-based wage increase for 2013 and an increase for 2014 based on the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) for the Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton area, June to June index, with a minimum increase of 2 percent and a maximum increase of 4 percent, and

WHEREAS an increase of 1.8 percent will be applied, retroactive to

January 1, 2013, for the classifications of Administrative Assistant, Benefit

Specialist (Retirement), Financial Assistant, and Office Assistant; and an increase
of 5 percent for the classification of Accountant and Senior Accountant, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the agreement, all classifications will receive a 2 percent increase effective January 1, 2014, and

WHEREAS City Council authorization is required to implement rates of pay and compensation within the collective bargaining agreement that has been negotiated with IBEW on behalf of its represented employees; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:



Section 1. That Section 1.12.355 of the Tacoma Municipal Code is hereby amended effective retroactive to January 1, 2013, to read as follows:

L483 Clerical. All employees covered by the 2011 – 2014 collective bargaining agreement, assigned to the Tacoma Police Department and employed as of January 1, 2010, will receive a one-time lump sum payment equal to 2% of their 2010 base pay rate in recognition of their contribution toward the achievement of the CALEA accreditation. This clause will sunset once payment has been made.

Section 4. That Section 1 of this ordinance shall become effective retroactive to January 1, 2013. That Section 2 of this ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2014. That Section 3 of this ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
