**SUMMARY:**

Appointing Chelsea McElroy to the Board of Ethics to serve a three-year term, effective January 1, 2021, to expire December 31, 2023.

**COUNCIL SPONSORS:**

Council Members Hines, Hunter, Thoms, and Walker.

**STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:**

Appointing an individual to the Board best aligns with the strategic priority policy related to encouraging and promoting an open, effective, results-oriented organization because the Board receives, investigates, and makes recommendations for disposition of complaints of violation of the Code of Ethics by current or former City-elected officials; the City Manager; the Director of Public Utilities; or a member of the Public Utility Board.

**BACKGROUND:**

At the November 3, 2020 Government Performance and Finance Committee meeting, the Committee conducted interviews and recommended the appointment of Chelsea McElroy to the Board of Ethics.

**ISSUE:**

A position needs to be filled on the Board of Ethics.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

The Board would operate without full membership.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

The Government Performance and Finance Committee is recommending the appointment of Chelsea McElroy.
