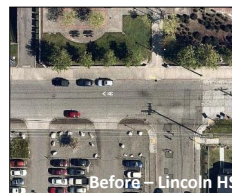
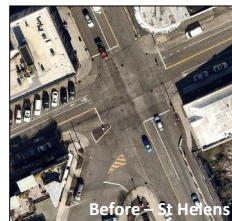

BACKGROUND



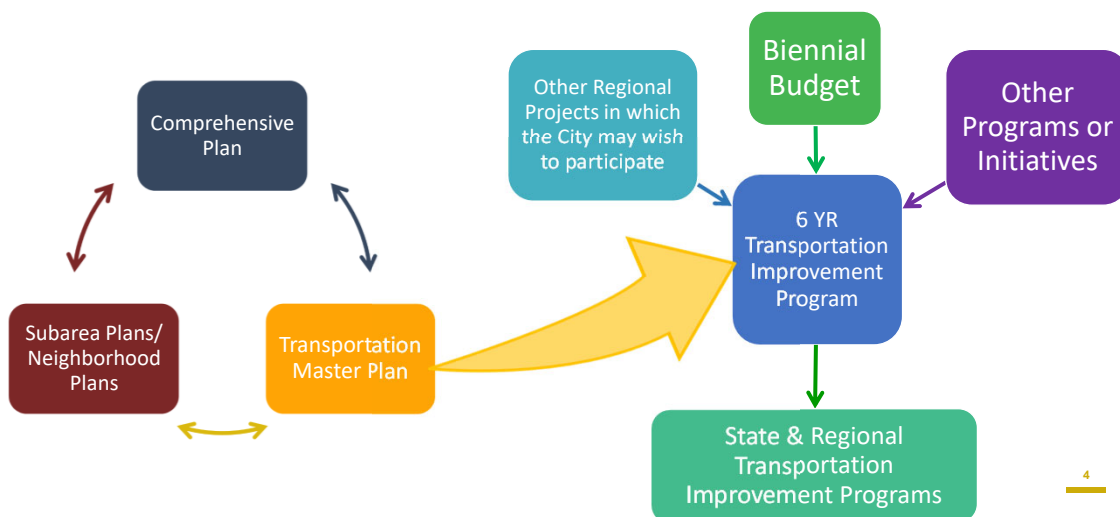
- RCW 35.77.010

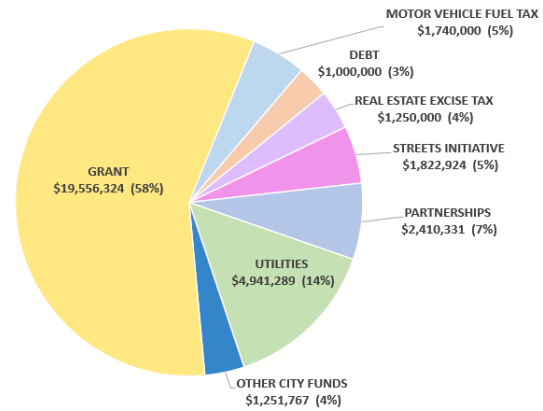

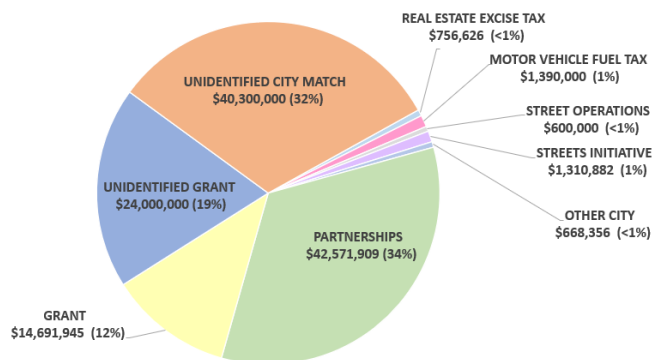

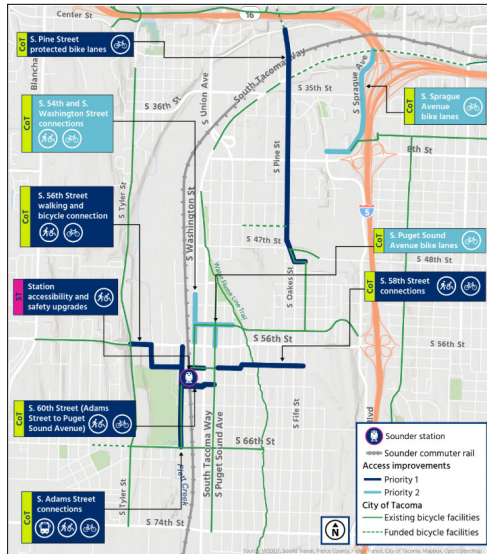

SOUND TRANSIT ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS – SOUTH TACOMA



Project Detail: This project includes preliminary engineering, final design, and construction of the selected Tier 1 and possibly Tier 2 priority projects that enhance pedestrian and bicycle safety and access, making it easier to walk, bike, roll and take local transit to the South Tacoma Sounder Station.

Funding: Sound Transit \$42,310,763

Project Detail: This project would plan and construct pedestrian, bicycle, traffic calming, and arterial crossing improvements along neighborhood greenways citywide.

Funding: Unidentified Grant \$18,000,000; Unidentified City Contribution \$6,000,000

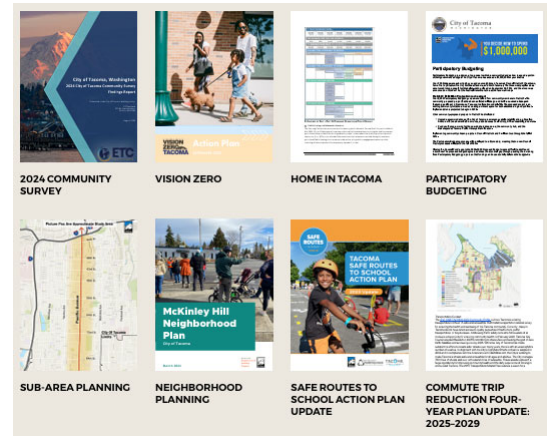
