1. Call to Order; Roll Call

Chair Cooks

Chair Cooks provided space for attendees to share public comment. There were no public comments made at this time.

5. Program Updates

Staff

Lisa Jaret acknowledged Ellana Meas, who was a meeting guest, but also the Mayor's Youth Commission member who was identified to fill the Youth seat on TCAB. There was a warm welcome from TCAB to Ellana.

Clarissa Gines provided information around staff's presentation to the Economic Development Committee of the City Council, as well as updates around the 2023-24 funding guidelines and application, including sharing information on upcoming application workshops, which she encouraged TCAB members to attend if they're able.

Lastly, Lisa shared that Tacoma Creates staff is being awarded as one of the Metro Parks Tacoma Park Champions for 2023 for the partnership with Beyond the Bell/Club Beyond, and the three community celebrations on the Eastside.

6. Action Item

Chair Cooks provided a recap of last month's election process for TCAB leadership and shared that TCAB leadership had a meeting with staff to discuss an amendment to the current election process, and presented that amendment to the rest of TCAB. She then asked for a motion, "to create a new two-year leadership position that would start this year, and have Brian Robinson serve as co-vice chair/chair elect this year and as chair next year, and to make this a continuing shift so that each year [TCAB] elects one person to a two-year term for TCAB leadership."

Chair Cooks let everyone know of some updated TCAB meeting dates for 2023 and noted that staff will send out reminders and updated calendar invites. An update was shared from the committee who discussed organizational identity amongst Tacoma Creates-funded organizations. TCAB members Katie Mattran and Amanda Figueroa, along with Chair Cooks were able to speak to the few updates that staff will be making to the application.

Tacoma Creates staff then talked through the handful of upcoming opportunities for TCAB members to engage in throughout the year, including serving on funding panels, and various committees.

Clarissa Gines provided information on a handful of upcoming opportunities that are currently open, including the Tacoma Artists Initiative Program (TAIP) funding, Tacoma Poet Laureate, Traffic Box Wraps, Mural Artist Roster, and Tacoma Mall Area Art Plan.

TCAB member Allison Campbell also shared some information about the state level Heritage Caucus, and encouraged TCAB members to participate if they are interested.
