

RESOLUTION NO. 38913

A RESOLUTION relating to the City Charter; setting Tuesday, June 10, 2014, at 5:30 p.m., as the date for a public hearing before the City Council to consider proposed amendments to the City Charter, as recommended by the 2014 Charter Review Committee, and all other potential amendments.

WHEREAS, on November 12, 2013, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 38773, creating a Charter Review Committee ("Committee"), consisting of 15 individuals, to begin a comprehensive review of the City Charter and make recommendations for changes it deemed necessary and proper to improve the mode and manner of operation and efficiency in conducting the affairs of the City, and

WHEREAS the Mayor and each City Council Member recommended one individual for appointment to the Committee, and the Government Performance and Finance Committee recommended the appointment of six individuals, and

WHEREAS the Committee and its five subcommittees met a total of approximately 59 times, between January and April, to complete its work, and

City Council accepted the final report and recommendations of the Committee, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 38900, adopted May 6, 2014, the

WHEREAS the City desires to fix a time and date for public hearing to consider proposed amendments to the City Charter, as recommended by the Committee, and all other potential amendments; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That Tuesday, June 10, 2014, at approximately 5:30 p.m., is hereby fixed as the time, and the City Council Chambers on the First Floor of the



 Tacoma Municipal Building, 747 Market Street, Tacoma, Washington, as the place when and where a public hearing shall be held to consider proposed amendments to the City Charter, as recommended by the 2014 Charter Review Committee, and all other potential amendments.

Section 2. That the City Clerk shall give proper notice of the time and place of said hearing.
