#### **ACTION REQUESTED**

### **TOPICS OF INTEREST**

- 2. Interim Information Technology Director Jack Kelanic is pleased to report that the City is being recognized for its top-ten ranking in the 2013 Digital Cities Survey and its progress in building a Digital City at the National League of Cities (NLC) Event next week in Seattle. The City has leveraged technology by providing cleaner and more functional web sites, new online payment options, a citizen request portal called CityQA, and established basic 311 telephone services connecting citizens with the City. The award reception will take place Friday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, 5:30-7:30 p.m., on the third floor of Union Tower in the Sheraton Seattle Hotel, located at 1400 Sixth Avenue, Seattle.

# STUDY SESSION/WORK SESSION

- 5. The City Council Study Session of Tuesday, November 12, 2013, will be held in Room 16 of the Tacoma Municipal Building North, at Noon. Discussion items will be: (1) Six-Year Transportation Program; (2) Other Items of Interest; (3) Agenda Review, and (4) Closed Session Labor Negotiations.
  - At Tuesday's Study Session, Public Works staff will present the **proposed** amendments to the *Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program Amended 2013-2014 & 2015-2020*. The Revised Code of Washington requires each city and town to annually update their comprehensive transportation program for the ensuing six calendar years and hold a public hearing. Public outreach has included a presentation to the Cross District Association, Community Council and the Infrastructure, Planning and Sustainability Committee. A public hearing is proposed for November 26<sup>th</sup>, and staff recommends adoption by the end of the year.

#### **GRANT AWARDS**

- 7. The City was awarded the following grant:
  - Department of Homeland Security Emergency Management Performance Grant Program - The Fire Department has been awarded funding to enhance and sustain all-hazards emergency management capabilities within the City of Tacoma. All activities funded by the grant must relate to the prevention, protection, response and recovery elements of emergency management. The City was awarded \$79,080, with a City match of \$79,080 required, which is earmarked in the biennial budget.
