



## RESOLUTION NO. 39879

1 A RESOLUTION relating to Click! Network; authorizing the City of Tacoma,  
2 Department of Public Utilities, Light Division, d.b.a. Click! Network, to  
3 accept a ten-year, non-exclusive Cable TV Franchise Agreement with  
4 the City of University Place for continued cable television operations.

4 WHEREAS, on January 6, 2003, the City of University Place granted a  
5 Franchise to the City of Tacoma, Department of Public Utilities, Light Division,  
6 d.b.a. Click! Network ("Click!"), for cable television services, and  
7

8 WHEREAS, on October 16, 2017, the University Place City Council  
9 approved Ordinance No. 695, granting a ten-year cable television Franchise  
10 Agreement ("Franchise") to Click! for the construction, operation of  
11 telecommunications facilities, and provision of cable television services, and  
12

13 WHEREAS the Franchise provides for the terms and conditions under which  
14 Click! will operate in the City of University Place, including compliance with  
15 right-of-way regulations, provision of evidence of insurance, payment of a  
16 five (5) percent franchise fee based on gross revenues generated from cable  
17 television operations within the City of University Place, and payment of 50 cents  
18 per subscriber per month capital fee, and

20 WHEREAS the Franchise contains two seven (7) year automatic renewal  
21 periods unless a party gives notice of intent not to renew, and  
22

23 WHEREAS it is in the best interests of Tacoma Power and its customers to  
24 accept the Franchise as recommended; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section. 1. That the request of the City of Tacoma, Department of Public Utilities, Light Division, d.b.a. Click! Network, to accept a ten-year, non-exclusive Cable TV Franchise Agreement granted by the City of University Place to Click! Network for the construction, operation of telecommunications facilities, and provision of cable television services, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the Superintendent of Tacoma Power is hereby authorized to enter into and execute on behalf of the City the Cable TV Franchise Agreement with the City of University Place, said document to be substantially in the form of the proposed agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk.
