



## RESOLUTION NO. 40466

1 BY REQUEST OF MAYOR WOODARDS AND COUNCIL MEMBERS BLOCKER,  
2 HUNTER, AND USHKA

3 A RESOLUTION authorizing the use of up to \$5,000 of City Council  
4 Contingency Funds, for expenses related to traffic control devices for  
5 the 2019 6th Avenue Santa Parade; and directing the City Manager to  
6 confirm deliverables for the funding commitment.

7 WHEREAS, whenever a special event produced by our community partners  
8 to promote their Neighborhood Business District requires a street closure, the  
9 City-issued Special Event Permit dictates the number of traffic control devices  
10 required, and

11 WHEREAS the event producers are responsible for acquiring barriers and  
12 the associated costs for these events, and

13 WHEREAS the 6th Avenue Santa Parade ("Parade") is a successful annual  
14 event in the 6th Avenue Business District which requires a Special Event Permit  
15 that dictates the number of traffic control devices required for its approved Traffic  
16 Control Plan ("Plan"), and based on the Plan, numerous traffic control devices will  
17 be required, and

18 WHEREAS the City Council adopted Resolution No. 40171 in 2018 for  
19 Council Contingency Fund support for the same traffic control devices required for  
20 this annual event, and

21 WHEREAS, at the October 29, 2019, Study Session, Council  
22 Member Hunter shared a Council Consideration Request to authorize the one-time  
23 use of up to \$5,000 from the Council Contingency Fund for costs related to traffic  
24 control devices for the Parade, and

1           WHEREAS City staff will confirm deliverables for the City’s contribution, and  
2           WHEREAS RCW 35.33.145 and 35.34.250 authorize a withdrawal from the  
3 Council Contingency Fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of  
4 which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of  
5 adopting the budget, and

7           WHEREAS the need for funding related to traffic control devices for the  
8 2019 Parade could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time the  
9 City adopted its biennial budget, and

11           WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less  
12 than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund; Now,  
13 Therefore,
