Company Incorporated ("Simon"), in the amount of \$25,000, for the purpose of
coordinating liaison and other related activities during the 1993 session of the
Washington State Legislature and the U.S. Congress, and

WHEREAS, on September 21, 1993, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 32332, authorizing the execution of Amendment No. 1 to the contract with Simon, in the amount of \$25,000, for a cumulative contract total of \$50,000, and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 1994, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 32855, authorizing the execution of Amendment No. 2 to the contract with Simon, in the amount of \$25,000, for a cumulative contract total of \$75,000, and

WHEREAS, on November 28, 1995, the City Council adopted
Resolution No. 33226, authorizing the execution of Amendment No. 3 to the
contract with Simon, in the amount of \$25,000, for a cumulative contract total of
\$100,000, and

contract with Simon, in the amount of \$37,500, for a cumulative contract total of
\$337,484, and

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2003, the City Council adopted
Resolution No. 36046, authorizing the execution of Amendment No. 11 to the
contract with Simon, in the amount of \$37,500, for a cumulative contract total of
\$374,984, and

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2004, the City Council adopted
Resolution No. 36356, authorizing the execution of Amendment No. 12 to the
contract with Simon, in the amount of \$37,500, for a cumulative contract total of
\$412,484, and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2006, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 37603, authorizing the execution of Amendment No. 13 to the contract with Simon, in the amount of \$130,000, for a cumulative contract total of \$542,484, and

WHEREAS the City will adopt a set of federal legislative priorities for the year 2009, and

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WHEREAS, in order to best achieve these priorities, it is necessary to retain the services of Simon and Company Incorporated to represent the City's interests before congress, the administration, federal regulatory agencies, and to assist City staff and members of the City Council when they travel to Washington, D.C., on City business; Now, Therefore,
