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ORDINANCE NO.

27992

L.I.D. No. 5729

AN ORDINANCE providing for the installation of a 12-inch water main crossing East D Street, creating Local Improvement District No. 5729; providing for a special fund for the payment of the improvements by special assessment upon the property within the district benefited thereby, for the issuance of warrants, installment notes, bond anticipation notes, or other short-term obligations to pay that part of the cost and expense of the improvements assessed against the property in the district, and for the payment of the remainder of the cost thereof.

WHEREAS all of the preliminary proceedings for the establishment of Local Improvement District ("L.I.D.") No. 5729 have been taken as provided by law, and

WHEREAS the Hearings Examiner of the City, after public hearing duly held, has recommended the formation of L.I.D. No. 5729 to the City Council; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That there shall be installation of a 12-inch water main crossing East D Street, and all other work necessary to complete the same in accordance with the plans and specifications to be prepared by the Tacoma Water Superintendent, together with all other work necessary to complete the project in accordance with the maps, plans, and specifications prepared and now on file in the office of the Director of the Department of Public Works, which maps, plans, and specifications are hereby adopted as follows:

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

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Installation of a 12-inch water main crossing East D Street, being approximately 15 feet south of the easterly extension of the northerly line of Parcel B, Boundary Line Adjustment MPD 2004-40000137475, recorded under Pierce County Auditor's File Number 2010-05-11-5001, from the existing 12-inch water main east of East D Street, thence west to a point approximately 40 feet west of East D Street.

Section 2. That there is hereby created a local improvement district, to be known as L.I.D. No. 5729, which shall contain all the property specially benefited by the improvements described above.

Section 3. That the estimated cost and expense of the improvements is \$125,000.00, which cost and expense shall be borne and assessed against the property included in, and benefitted by, the L.I.D.

The assessments levied against the property described above shall become due and payable at the option of the property owners in cash, without interest, within 30 days after publication of the notice of assessment, or in ten equal annual installments with interest on deferred payments at a rate to be hereafter fixed, but in no event greater than .05 percent above the rate of interest fixed upon sale of bond for the district; and each year one of such installments, together with interest due thereon and on all installments thereafter to become due, shall be collected in the manner provided by law.

Section 4. That a special fund is hereby created, to be called Local Improvement Fund, District No. 5729, which shall consist in the aggregate of the various amounts assessed, levied, and collected upon the several lots and parcels of land in the local improvement district for the purpose of defraying the



cost and expense of the improvements to be borne by the property within the district, and into which fund shall be deposited the proceeds of the sale of warrants, installment notes, bond anticipation notes, or other short-term obligations drawn against the fund which may be sold by the City. Out of the fund shall be paid the warrants, installment notes, bond anticipation notes, or other short-term obligations, interest thereon, and the cost of the improvement to be borne by the property included in the district.

Section 5. The Tacoma Water Superintendent is hereby ordered to call for bids for said improvements, and to proceed and complete the improvements and to make out and certify to the City Council an assessment roll, all as provided by law.

In case no bid is accepted, the Tacoma Water Superintendent is hereby authorized to proceed and complete the improvements by the method of day labor or force account and by use of materials, supplies, and equipment, as authorized by the City Charter and ordinances of the City. The Director of Public Works shall keep a separate account of the expenditures as made and the exact cost of the improvements separately computed. Upon certification by the Director of Public Works that any sums are due to any person for labor or materials for the improvements, the proper officers shall issue a payment therefor drawn upon the L.I.D. Fund, District No. 5729. The Director of Public Works shall certify to the City Council the assessment roll on the property as provided by law.

Section 6. Under the provisions of the laws of the state of Washington, amendments thereto, and this ordinance, there shall be issued warrants,

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installment notes, bond anticipation notes, or other short-term obligations, issued pursuant to Ordinance No. 23412, as it may be amended, in payment of the cost and expense of the district, payable out of the Local Improvement District Fund. Such warrants, installment notes, bond anticipation notes, or other short-term obligations shall bear interest from the date of their issuance at a rate to be hereafter fixed by the Director of the Department of Finance in accordance with Ordinance No. 23412, and shall be redeemed from the Local Improvement District Fund or by other warrants, installment notes, bond anticipation notes, or other short-term obligations, or from the proceeds of local improvement bonds hereafter issued.

Section 7. Pursuant to the provisions of the laws of the state of Washington, the City Council hereby directs that the improvements be paid for by the City in cash and that the warrants, installment notes, bond anticipation notes, or other short-term obligations authorized to be issued under the provisions of this ordinance be sold by the proper officers of the City in accordance with



Ordinance No. 23412, as it may be amended, and that the proceeds therefrom shall be applied in payment of the cost and expense of the improvement.
