**SUMMARY:**

Reappointing Addison Atkatsh to the “youth member” position on the Human Services Commission to serve a one-year term, retroactive to July 1, 2024, to expire June 30, 2025.

**STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:**

Appointing individuals to the Human Services Commission (“Commission”) best aligns with the strategic policy priority related to strengthening and supporting public safety and human services as the Commission serves as a resource to the City Council and City staff for implementation of the City's Human Services.

**BACKGROUND:**
