## **Briefing Items**

1. <u>23-0810</u> Neighborhood Planning Program Update

At approximately 12:00 p.m, Lauren Hoogkamer, Principal Planner, Planning and Development Services (PDS), introduced Anneka Olson, Senior Planner, PDS, and presented a brief background on the Neighborhood Planning Program. Olson presented the McKinley Hill Neighborhood Plan, noting a summary, key plan recommendations, and implementation; the Proctor Neighborhood Plan, noting a timeline summary, engagement, goals, actions, and proposed actions.

Council Member Daniels arrived here, at 12:09 p.m.

Olson continued with an overview of the community booster project. Hoogkamer concluded with the pilot program, noting lessons learned; proposed criteria for future plans; neighborhood centers under consideration; neighborhood planning program capacity; and proposed next steps.

Discussion ensued regarding gratitude for the great work from staff; South Tacoma Way recommendation, noting Strategic Neighborhood Action Plan program and funding; community engagement; timelines; asset mapping; common themes around neighborhood centers; priorities and progress of other

neighborhood programs; implementation of future neighborhood plans, including South Tacoma; collaboration with the South End Neighborhood Council; zoning; neighborhood districts; capacity and community needs; and Council direction on various mixed-use centers and districts.
