SUMMARY:

The Environmental Services Department recommends a contract be awarded to Western Peterbilt, LLC, Seattle, WA, in the amount of \$1,088,460 (\$1,104,360 minus trade-in allowance of \$15,900), plus applicable sales tax, budgeted from the ES Solid Waste Fund 4200, to purchase four compressed natural gas (CNG) rear loader trucks, for an initial one-year term, with the option to renew for two additional one-year terms, to purchase a total of seven CNG rear loader trucks, for a projected contract total of \$2,047,286.

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

• Strengthen and maintain a strong fiscal management position.

• Foster neighborhood, community, and economic development vitality and sustainability.

The CNG rear loaders will enable Solid Waste Management's (SWM) truck fleet to operate more efficiently using CNG fuel and reduce environmental impacts by decreasing greenhouse gas and particulate emissions.

BACKGROUND:

ISSUE: The proposed rear loader trucks will replace four crane low forward cab rear loader trucks that have exceeded their 12-year life cycle and are significantly worn and no longer cost effective to maintain and keep in service. The selected vehicles will have CNG capabilities contributing to less carbon emissions and significant fuel savings. The rear loader trucks will be used to collect solid waste from commercial customers.

Staff is requesting to initially purchase four trucks, with the option to renew the contract for three additional trucks in the 2017-2018 biennium. The projected contract total includes an estimated five percent inflation factor over two years.

ALTERNATIVES: The alternative to purchasing four CNG rear loader trucks would be to purchase diesel rear loader trucks. The traditional diesel trucks are less expensive, however fuel costs, maintenance costs, and carbon emissions are substantially higher than the CNG rear loader trucks. Purchasing diesel rear loader trucks doesn't meet the City's sustainability priorities.

COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION: Request for Bids Specification No. ES15-0692F opened March 15, 2016. Five companies were invited to bid, in addition to normal advertising of the project. Five submittals were received. Western Systems was the lowest bidder but was not selected because they did not comply with the specification requirements as outlined in the bid documents. Therefore Western Peterbilt, LLC is the lowest bidder. The table below reflects the amount of the total award.

Pre-bid Estimate: \$1,040,000

The recommended award is one percent above the pre-bid estimate.

CONTRACT HISTORY: New contract.

SUSTAINABILITY: These vehicles will possess a CNG engine instead of a diesel engine contributing to 23 percent to 88 percent reduction in greenhouse gas emissions over diesel.
