- Appointing Eunice T Ngwasi kalembo to the "Alternate" position to fill an unexpired term, to expire March 31, 2025.
- Reappointing Maurice Lekea to serve a three-year term, retroactive to April 1, 2024, to expire March 31, 2027.
- Reappointing Samantha Le to serve a three-year term retroactive to April 1, 2024, to expire March 31, 2027.
