SUMMARY:

Appointing and reappointing the following individuals to the Landmarks Preservation Commission:

- Appointing Anahita Modrek to the “Architect 2” position to fill an unexpired term, to expire December 31, 2025.
- Appointing Gia Mugford to the “Wedge Ex Officio” position to fill an unexpired term, to expire December 31, 2027.
- Reappointing Alex Morganroth to the “At-Large 1” position to serve a three-year term, retroactive to January 1, 2024, to expire December 31, 2026.

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

As the Landmarks Preservation Commission (Commission) oversees the establishment and regulation of landmarks, local historic districts, proposed name changes for public facilities, and certain property tax incentives, appointing individuals to the Commission best aligns with the strategic policy priority to foster neighborhood, community, and economic development vitality and sustainability.

BACKGROUND:

At the April 10, 2024, Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee meeting, the Committee conducted interviews and recommended the appointment and reappointment of the individuals listed above.

ISSUE:

Positions need to be filled on the Landmarks Preservation Commission.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Commission will continue to operate without full membership.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee is recommending the appointment and reappointment of the individuals listed above.
