BY REQEUST OF COUNCIL MEMBERS HINES, HUNTER, AND USHKA

A RESOLUTION relating to City committees, boards, and commissions; increasing the membership composition of the Commission on Immigrant and Refugee Affairs, established on December 12, 2017, pursuant to Resolution No. 39892, from 11 to 13 members.

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2017, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 39892, establishing a Commission on Immigrant and Refugee Affairs ("CIRA"), to be composed of 11 members and an alternate, for the purpose of better engaging immigrant and refugee communities and to work with community partners and staff to identify and advance positive outcomes related to removing barriers for said communities, and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2021, CIRA presented its annual report to the Community Vitality and Safety Council Committee, and

WHEREAS one item highlighted in the presentation is that CIRA is an active commission with work being done in multiple subcommittees; currently, some Commissioners serve on more than one subcommittee which creates capacity limitations for CIRA's work, and

WHEREAS CIRA has requested that its membership be expanded by two members, from 11 to 13, in order to better distribute the work of the Commission; Now, Therefore,
